17TH AGM CONVENED

The 17th Annual General Meeting (AGM) of shareholders was convened on January 8, 2010 under the chairmanship of Mr. Padma Jyoti, the Chairman of the Board of Directors, at Head Office, Baneshwor, Kathmandu.

The shareholders actively participated in discussion.

The AGM approved the Board of Directors Report; Financial Statement for F.Y. 2065/66 and 20% cash dividend to the shareholders from the net profit of F.Y. 2065/66.

Special resolutions to issue 10% dividend and right shares in a ratio of 3:2, and to amend the Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association of the company with the increase of authorized capital to Rs. 8 Billion and paid-up capital to Rs. 1.69 Billion.

Mr. Nirmal Pradhan has been elected as Director representing public shareholders for four years.

FOUNDATION STONE LAID FOR BPC GREEN BUILDING

On an auspicious day of 8 February 2010, Chairman of BPC Mr. Padma Jyoti laid the foundation stone for the Company's New Building in its complex, Buddhanagar, Kathmandu. The proposed BPC new building is going to be the first building in Nepal to be accredited with prestigious LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certification by US Green Building Council based at Washington.

The design works of the proposed BPC building is based on latest international green building construction technologies. In the meantime, a great deal of attention has been taken to achieve the climate responsive design. The New Building has also adopted the Vaastu Shastra Principles as far as possible.

Building Information

The building consists of 9 floors with 2 basements area for vehicles parking. Architectural and Engineering (A/E) design has been carried out by a Nepali A/E Consultant. The contract for construction work has been signed with a Nepali Contractor and the construction work is already started. The construction project is envisaged to be completed within 2 years.

Green Building Components

Following green building design components have been incorporated in the Project:

- Use of on-site renewable energy such as: Solar Energy, Earth Air Tunnel and Wind Turbine.
- 2. Use of world class energy efficient practices such as:

Double Glazed Windows, Heat Insulation, Energy Efficient Appliances, Building Management System (BMS), Orientation and Opening of Building.

3. Efficient and Effective use of Materials and Resources such as:

Storage and collection of recyclables, Reuse of building materials, Less use of wood, Reduction in usage of potable water, 100% recycling of waste water, Water efficient landscaping, Rainwater harvesting, Underground water charging, Landscape to reduce heat island effect, Non-use of Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC), Indoor Air Quality (IAQ), Earthquake resistance building.

BPC JV AND GON INKS PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF KABELI-A PROJECT

Kabeli Energy Limited, a SPV established by BPC JV signed Project Development Agreement with Government of Nepal on January 31, 2010 for development of Kabeli-A project under BOOT basis.

The partners in the SPV are Sangri-la Energy Limited (Nepal), SCP Hydro International (Canada), Asia Pacific Power Tech Limited (China) and Khudi Hydropower Limited.

The PDA was signed at a function held at the Ministry of Energy in presence of Honorable Minister of Energy, Secretary Ministry of Energy, BPC Chairman and Kabeli Energy Chairman.

To celebrate the event BPC had hosted a dinner at Hotel Yak & Yeti on February 2nd 2010 where distinguished guests like Minister for Energy Prakash Sharan Mahat and Chairman of Constituent Assembly Subash Chandra Nembang were also present in the program.

About the Project

The project is located in Panchthar and Taplejung districts in the Eastern Region. Kabeli - A with capacity of 30 MW is a run off river project with daily pondage. The estimated total annual energy production is 164 GWh. The project is estimated to cost 56 Million USD (about 4 Billion NRs.). The project is expected to take four years for construction and is will start commercial production in 2014/15. Prior to start of construction the EIA shall be updated as per World Bank standards.

Project Financing

Kabeli - A is the first project of its kind in Nepal that has access to Power Development Fund (soft loan arrangement by the World Bank). The World Bank through Power Development Fund (PDF) will provide 40% loan, local banks will fund 40% and 20% will be equity investment by promoters.
