Welcome Speech by Padma Jyoti, Chairman, BPC Launch of JV Cooperation – Kathmandu 22nd November 2017

This is the solemn commitment China has made to promote common development in the world by enhancing international cooperation. Nepal Government has decided to participate in this initiative for the benefit of our country.

Tonight on behalf of BPC let me express our great pleasure in starting a new partnership with the Chinese companies. We are very glad that you have chosen Nepal as the target country for investment. We are doubly pleased that you have chosen BPC as a partner. Thank you very much.

This new partnership between BPC Nepal and SCIG, CXIG and QYEC of China combines the strengths of our companies very well. We are companies who share a common belief in professionalism, mutual trust and long term relations.

This Joint Venture cooperation will develop minimum one thousand megawatts in the next five years in projects in Nepal with investment of Two Billion US Dollars.

I am confident that the launch of this joint cooperation today is only the first step in a long and successful journey together in hydropower in Nepal.

BPC is a company which is a pioneer in a number of fields in the Nepalese corporate world. Thousands of public shareholders active in the stock exchange, a group of leading private sector companies, Government of Nepal, Nepal Electricity Authority,
